

# COUNTRY OAKIE COKIE

Music – Country Oakie Cokie by **Bob McKinley**

**1-Wall fun dance (Start after 16 counts when Bob sings – “Do the Country Oakie Cokie”)**

**Feel The Beat** have been teaching this dance at festivals all over the country as a fun party dance. Unfortunately all copies of the music had previously been sold, so we would like to say a special thank you to **Mr Bob McKinley** for giving **Feel The Beat** permission to make and distribute copies of his original music for the dance. (To order copies ring 01952 414284).

The original script for this dance was written by **Dave & the 2-k’s** from **Bidd’s Country Club** at Stoke-On Trent. With their permission we are using only the chorus steps (as below) from the original script which are repeated through the dance.

You will need to listen to the music to get the sequence right but it is really easy to follow and well worth the effort.

## “ALL YOU NEED TO LEARN ARE THESE 3 – SECTIONS”

**SECTION-1** 1-8 Right vine & touch left by right  
Left full rolling vine & touch right by left

**SECTION-2** 1-8 2 x ½ Monteray turns

**SECTION-3** 1-8 Split heels apart – heels together  
Right foot brush – right foot stomp  
hands 3 times (clap clap clap) & hold 1-beat

## THE DANCE PATTERN

**Alan’s Note:- Bob sings the words in the lyrics throughout the dance**

Begin the dance with all 3-sections as printed above and repeat the whole section again for a 2<sup>nd</sup> time.

Now follow the music i.e. “put right boot in” – “out” etc....

After each of these sections comes the “**Country Oakie Cokie chorus**” – listen to the music!!!!!!

The first part will be a just a single right vine & touch - left rolling vine & touch followed by the Split heels section with hand claps.

Following this do all 3-sections and then follow the other **Country Oakie Cokie** instructions right hip in – left hip in – right arm in – left arm in – whole self in doing the chorus in between each section.
